Northern Grampians Shire councillors prefer option 1 with 7 Councillors and an unsubdivided shire. This preference is based on three reasons. Firstly, having a non-even number of councillors will unlikely result in tied resolutions in Council Meetings. Secondly, option 2 with 3 wards of 6 councillors splits the town of Stawell in two along the railway line which would create an artificially demarcation of the town. Thirdly, option 1 being unsubdivided will reduce the likelihood of uncontested election positions and give more people an opportunity to represent the residents of the shire.
