I respectfully submit that the Mount Alexander shire should be represented by an unsubdivided council with seven councillors elected by proportional voting for the following reasons:

- 1. Proportional voting will be applied in an even manner across the Shire
- 2. Councillors will be responsible for decision making based on a whole of shire approach
- 3. The majority of councillors will be elected by the majority of voters across the shire.
- 4. An unsubdivided council reduces the possibility that candidates may stand in a particular ward with lower quotas to disproportionally represent single issues
- 5. Diversity of interests, such as environmental concerns, child care, business interests, aged care, youth services and local planning, will be better represented
- 6. There will not be a future requirement to adjust ward boundaries with population changes.
- 7. Voters have a larger group of councillors to vote from, rather than a small ward based group.
