To whom it may concern these new boundaries are III conceived and even go against your own guidelines by going over the +/- 10% it also splits communities in half of even less. It also doesn't take into consideration topographic and travel challenges throughout the shire. My main concerns are the the size of Koriella and Cathedral ward for a councillor to go from point to point within these wards could take well over 2 hours in the proposed models you have listed. My other concern is the growth of towns like buxton and marysville inside the the Cathedral ward both of these towns appear from the outside to be growing faster than all other towns in the Shire outside of Yea.

One more concern for the Cathedral ward is what chance is there of proper representation of the towns on the west side of the shire (toolangi and murrindindi) as I doubt someone from these towns would ever run for council as it would be too difficult for them to travel to the majority of their ward on a regular basis, this would also be reflected in the Koriella ward with people from strath Creek. Please consider what is best for the councillors and constituents when making your final determination as every single person I have spoken to about this thinks these new boundaries are a horrible idea.
