My submission is in support of model 2 with some modifications.

Kirrip Park, Lakeside and South Melbourne.

With the predicted growth in population in the proposed wards of Kirrip Park, Lakeside and South Melbourne, I suggest that, initially, these wards should have fewer voters per ward to allow for population growth given the new high-rise apartments and conversion of office buildings into apartments.

I support the proposed names and approximate boundaries.

Catani.

I support the basic scope of this ward, but the name could be confused with the previous council "Catani ward" and doesn't reflect the residents who live kilometres from the Catani Gardens, A suggestion is to call this ward, "Parks".

The ward should not be called "Albert Park" as this will confuse voters as "Albert Park" is the name of the State seat.

I believe the ward boundary should be on Mary St as these residents are close to redeveloping Fitzroy St.

St Kilda.

I support the name of this ward as it reflects the suburb's name and well known to residents both sides of Fitzroy St.

I recommend that the residents who live in St Kilda between Fitzroy St, Acland St, Victoria St and the Upper Esplanade be included in the St Kilda ward.

The voter numbers could be changed by shifting the boundary from Dickens st to Blessington St.

Port Melbourne, Elwood, Balaclava and St Kilda East.

I support these names and boundaries, noting my suggestions to modify the boundaries as outlined above.
