Dear guardians of democracy.

I submit the proposed 9 ward structure for the City of Port Phillip (I used the mapping tool to create 9 wards within the required tolerances).

The key goals of the proposal are to maintain coherent neighbourhoods by grouping areas based on their geographic boundaries, such as main roads, parkland, and established local areas.

The key element of this proposal for consideration in a final model is the shape of the two wards east of Brighton Road. Brighton Road is a natural boundary, and should be used as the western edge of two wards (Alma and Carlisle). These two wards should not extend west across Brighton Road, nor should they extend north of St Kilda Junction.
