The population of Lorne is a mixed of full time and part time residents all with a stronger than normal commitment to Place. The voting role is not the best guide

It would be far better to create a coastal town borough say from Anglesea to Apollo Bay as the mix and interests have much more in common with the Torquay which is becoming more and more a suburb of Geelong. The rate base base from my calculations is sufficient to support such Borough - similar to Queenscliff.
