Dear City of Hume Electoral Representation Advisory Panel,

As a member of the Victorian Legislative Council, covering significant parts of the City of Hume, I write to you with my concerns over the proposed boundaries for the Hume City Council across all three proposed models.

In all three models, the Kalkallo locality is combined with the northern parts of Craigieburn. These two localities have significantly different communities of interest. The north-eastern parts of Craigieburn are some of the most established parts of the City of Hume, whereas the Kalkallo and Mickleham areas are the newest, with a significantly different population composition.

A better alternative would be to combine the growth suburbs of Mickleham and Kalkallo into one ward.

Failing this, Model Three is *prima facie* the most sensible option, as it best unites communities of interest, while accounting for projected population growth in the booming parts of the locality.

I am happy to appear before or have a staff member appear on my behalf at the public hearing on Wednesday 28 November.
