

Electoral structure review - Casey City Council - Response Submission

This is a supplemental map submission to my original submission, using the VEC tool to better estimate voter distribution.

From my initial submission, the suburb of Eumemmerring was shifted between wards to get the deviation of the Gleneagles and Maramba Wards closer to the +10% limit.

As it is, this model slightly exceeds the +10%, however I argue that this is acceptable, noting the extremely large population growth that Casey is undergoing (and hence the total voter count only needs to increase by ~2,000 for the deviation to return to under the 10% limit.

Note that the boundaries drawn differ also slightly from the model that I used, as this VEC model did not have any zone boundaries along the Eumemmerring Creek or Hallam Creek (I tried to follow it as closely as possible).

Additionally, I expanded Grasmere Ward slightly further south to the Monash Freeway from the Pakenham railway to increase the ward population (to allow for more growth in the southern wards).

All my other points from my original submission are the same as initially mentioned.
