While I dislike the movement away from multi-member wards to single councillor wards, I understand this was out of your control.

From the models you've provided, I prefer model 1. I will only address the southern part of Merri-Bek, up to Fawkner where I am more familiar.

South of Moreland Road, while there are better transport links running North South along Sydney and Lygon Road, the services people access come from an east west direction as they congregate towards the major roads, hence I don't mind having an east west ward alignment with major roads being the focal point. Having a natural Brunswick East and West wards is appropriate.

North of Moreland Road, the suburb-centric wards of model 1 make more sense to me than the use Sydney Road as a border, even with the trade-off of using small streets.

In terms of ward names, I really like using local features and so was drawn to their use in model 2. I would like those names, where appropriate, to be used in naming the wards for model 1. In the table below I have attempted to use park names as a theme to bind all the wards of Merri-bek.
